

The Princeton Closet Scholarship

The Princeton Closet Scholarship in Memory of Shirley and Dale Espel is presented annually to at least three high school graduating seniors that reside in Bureau County with consideration given to the qualifications and information listed below.

The award is a one-time, non-renewable scholarship in the amount of at least \$1000. The scholarship monies will be sent directly to the junior college, college, university, or trade school (technical or vocational) the recipient will attend once confirmation of enrollment is received by The Princeton Closet. The scholarship selection committee consists of appointed members from Bureau County.

We are a mission-based organization that gives back to the community. To support our mission, we ask our scholarship recipients to volunteer at The Princeton Closet for at least 10 hours during the summer before they start college or trade school.

To qualify for this scholarship, you must:

- Intend to complete a two- or four-year degree or trade school program.
- Enroll as a full-time student at an accredited junior college, college, university, or trade school.
- Reside in Bureau County and be a student at Bureau Valley, Hall, St. Bede, Ohio, DePue, La
 Moille, Princeton Christian Academy, or Princeton High School for at least one academic year
 immediately prior to graduation.

Application Process:

- A. Find the Scholarship application document on our website at princeton closet.com, under the Applications tab.
- B. Download and review this entire document which includes the scholarship application form at the end. The application is a fillable form in PDF. Adobe Reader software is available here if you need it.
- C. Do not use artificial intelligence (AI) to prepare any part of the application and requested information. All documents will be scanned for the use of AI and if found, your application will be denied.
- D. Fill out the application completely.
- E. Prepare a separate document with the following information.
 - 1. Related to your high school experience detail any honors, awards, achievements, extracurricular activities, and leadership positions.
 - 2. Related to your service and/or work in the community detail any volunteer activities, honors, achievements, and leadership positions.
 - 3. Related to your Christian life detail your personal faith story and your Christian service.
- F. Obtain a copy of your high school transcript.
- G. Obtain two letters of reference from people who know you well. Please do not use relatives.
- H. Attach the completed application, additional information, transcript, and reference letters to an email and send the email to The Princeton Closet at the princeton closet@gmail.com.



- I. Make sure all attached files do not need permissions to be opened.
- J. Be sure the attached files are not larger than 1 MB each.
- K. Please do not hardcopy mail or hand deliver your application materials including your reference letters to The Princeton Closet. They must be emailed to the princeton closet@gmail.com.
- L. The Princeton Closet will send an acknowledgement email to you within a business week. Please contact us at the princeton closet@gmail.com if you don't hear back.
- M. Maintain your copy in your email sent file until you hear back from us.
- N. All application materials must be received by April 1 at midnight.
