



The Princeton Closet Scholarship

The Princeton Closet Scholarship in Memory of Shirley and Dale Espel is presented annually to at least three high school graduating seniors that reside in Bureau County with consideration given to the qualifications and information listed below.

The award is a one-time, non-renewable scholarship in the amount of at least \$1000. The scholarship monies will be sent directly to the trade school (technical or vocational), junior college, college, or university the recipient will attend once confirmation of college enrollment is received by The Princeton Closet. The scholarship selection committee consists of appointed members from Bureau County.

We are a mission-based organization that gives back to the community. To support our mission, we strongly suggest our scholarship recipients volunteer at The Princeton Closet for at least 10 hours during the summer of 2024 before they start college.

To qualify for this scholarship, you must:

- Intend to complete a two- or four-year degree or trade school program.
- Enroll as a full-time student at an accredited trade school, junior college, college, or university.
- Reside in Bureau County and be a student at Bureau Valley, Hall, St. Bede, Ohio, DePue, LaMoille, or Princeton High School for at least one academic year immediately prior to graduation.

Please provide the following information using this numbering system in addition to completing the application form:

1. Honors, awards, achievements, and extracurricular activities associated with your high school experience including leadership positions.
2. Volunteer activities and organizations you work with in the community including leadership positions, honors, and achievements.
3. Your personal faith story along with your Christian service.
4. High school transcript.
5. Two letters of reference from people who know you well. Please do not use relatives.

Application Summary:

 - b. Note that attached files should not be larger than 1 MB each.
